Republican Party Abandons Base, Conservative Republicans Must Unite ...

My name is Wayne Long and I am the executive director of the National Conservative Republican Alliance (NCRA). The NCRA is a newly formed grassroots, political organization. I write today to explain our mission and to invite some of you to join with us to reclaim the Republican Party for Conservatism. The NCRA has 1) identified the problem, 2) found a solution, 3) identified the specific group who is going to implement the plan, and 4) developed a strategic plan to accomplish our mission. Let me now, address each of these topics and then offer an invitation.

The Problem:

The Republican Party has a very big problem. The problem with the Republican Party is that it has abandoned its conservative base and drifted to the left, becoming weak and anemic. Too many of our elected representatives are eager to “reach across the aisle”, in the name of “bi-partisanship”; rather than, stand up and defend and protect our conservative values and principles. We see our country failing before our very eyes. We are extremely disappointed in the Republican Party, at the national level.

The Solution:

The solution to our problem is to give the Republican Party a transfusion of conservative representatives. We will flood the party with candidates who will pledge to honor the core values and beliefs of the people that elect them. The candidates we support will

aggressively and consistently advocate for the policy issues that we determine are our priorities.

We will purge the Republican Party of unresponsive, arrogant politicians who ignore the will of the people who elect them. And, if we can not defeat them in the primary with a conservative candidate, we will help defeat them in the general and look forward to the next primary, without an incumbent RINO (Republican In Name Only) standing in the way. A RINO elected official is not better than a Democrat. We will no longer be content to vote for the lesser of two evils. A RINO, remaining in office, only slows us down in getting to where we need to be. This is a big problem and it may take several election cycles. The Republican Party must return to it's conservative values.

Specific Group:

I believe the Republican Party is made up of two main groups: firstly, there are the “politically active” moderates, and secondly, there are the “complacent” conservatives. I firmly believe that the larger of these groups is the “complacent” conservatives, the “Silent Majority”, the “Sleeping Giant”.

You might say, “Wayne we’re all Republicans, how can you make that distinction?”

Let me ask you a few questions:

1. Were you thrilled and excited when the Republican Party nominated John McCain, last year?
2. Were you enthusiastic when McCain lined up with the Global Warming crowd?
3. Were you happy when George Bush and John McCain tried to ram Amnesty down our throats?
4. Were you fine with our team getting very little accomplished when we had the majority in both houses and the White House?
5. Were you onboard with the extreme spending during the last eight years?
6. Were you proud of Specter, Snow and Collins for voting with the liberal Democrats for the Bailout Bill?

7. Were you feeling warm and fuzzy when our team voted with the liberal Democrats to target individuals with an unconstitutional tax to punish them for accepting contractual compensation?

If you answered yes to any of these questions, the National Conservative Republican Alliance is not the organization for you.

If on the other hand, you were outraged and felt betrayed by what you consider to be your own party, you are invited to join with us and get busy being a part of the solution. You are a part of our specific group of individuals who is going to implement our strategic plan.

Strategic Plan:

Our strategic plan is to identify, unite and organize “complacent” Conservative Republicans, who will transform into determined, motivated “politically active” Conservative Republicans.

NCRA members will form into precinct chapters all across the country. As new members join, they do two things: 1) they acknowledge agreement to NCRA Core Beliefs and 2) they prioritize their individual TOP TEN policy issues. Their TOP TEN issues are scored 1 through 10, with 10 having the highest priority. Then their individual Top Ten are averaged into the total, resulting in a combined, NCRA TOP TEN. Our Core Beliefs, our TOP TEN and our commitment to put our party and our country back on the right track will be the glue that binds us together.

We will meet in homes and get acquainted. We will act as a voting block at the precinct level and beyond. We will become a movement within the Republican Party. I refer to this as Precinct Power. This is nothing new, but it requires an organization, a plan and motivated, likeminded people. The NCRA website will be our national meeting place. We will take polls, submit petitions, send out “calls to action”, ask our elected officials to sign our Politician’s Pledge, discuss events and issues on our message board, post

approved politicians and candidates, post others to the RINO Gallery, and eventually we will develop state NCRA chapters to focus on state issues.

Invitation:

So my message to you “complacent” Conservative Republicans, the time has come for you to wake up. Your country is in trouble. You no longer have the luxury of remaining on the sideline. We need you in the game. We need you to host and attend meetings with your NCRA precinct chapter. We need you to be delegates to your state conventions. We need you to elect NCRA conservatives to your Republican Party leadership. We need you to submit resolutions to the Republican Party Platform that defines who we are. We need you to nominate NCRA conservatives to represent us in the White House and Congress. We need you to oppose the rush to Socialism and the Democrats’ determined effort to nationalize our health care system. We need you to demand that our federal government secure our borders and enforce our laws. We need you to demand our right to keep and bear arms. We need you to oppose the, so called, Fairness Doctrine, designed to restrict our political speech. We need you to protect the lives of the innocent. We need you to search out and find the leaders within the NCRA that have courage, vision and determination. We need you to defend our sovereignty, our individual liberties, our traditions, our Christian values and our very way of life.
